Match One: Trinity

Range: 150 yards

Target: Fig 11

Ammunition: 17 Rounds (2 sighters, 15 scoring)

Position: As standard

Exposure: One minute per position.

Comments Slings optional. Shots indicated Max pts 75

Match Two: Beersheba

Range: 300 yards

Target: Fig 11

Ammunition: 12 Rounds (2 sighters, 10 scoring)

Position: Prone

Exposure: Within reason.

Comments Slings optional. Shots indicated Max pts 50

Match Three: Run down

Range: 300 yards

Target: Fig 11

Ammunition: 10 rounds

Position: Optional

Exposure: 90 seconds

Comments: 100 metres semis / 50 metres bolts. Ammo/mags on mound. Run 100/50 metres with cleared rifle then load and engage target. Shot supported NB: If you have mobility problems, this can be countered for. Max pts 50

Match Four: Snap 300

Range: 300 yards

Target: Fig 11

Ammunition: 10 rounds

Position: Start standing, shooting position optional

Exposure: 5 x 10 secs

Comments: Start standing with hot rifle, safety on. On command, adopt position and fire two rounds. Return to standing. Repeat 5 times. Slings optional Max pts 50

Match Five: Sgt Nicholas VC

Range: 500 yards

Target: Type A

Ammunition: 12 rounds (2 sighters, 10 scoring)



Position: Prone
Exposure: 10 x of 30 secs each.
Comments: Supported: Slings optional. Shots indicated Max pts 50

Match Six: Trinity 100 Max pts 75

Range: 100 yards
Target: Figure 12
Ammunition: 17 Rounds (2 sighters, 15 scoring)
Position: 5 rounds standing 5 rounds sitting, kneeling or squatting 5 rounds prone
Exposure: One minute per position
Comments: No slings. Adequate time is allowed for position change and reloads.

Match Seven: Action M Max pts 50

Range: 100 yards
Target: Figure 12
Ammunition: 10 rounds
Position: Prone-standing-sitting, kneeling or squatting-standing-prone (M)
Exposure: 75 seconds bolt action, 60 seconds self-loading
Comments: Start standing behind rifle (loaded magazine, bolt closed, empty chamber). On command fire two shots from each position with reload after fifth shot.

Match Eight: Rapid Trinity 100 Max pts 75

Range: 100 yards
Target: Figure 12
Ammunition: 15 rds
Position: 5 rounds standing, 5 rounds sitting, kneeling or squatting, 5 rounds prone
Exposure: 60 secs semis 75 secs bolts
Comments: No slings. Shot as a serial, no stopping, reload only once in position.

Match Nine: Kaitoke Turn-Around Max pts 50

Range: 100 yards
Target: Figure 12
Ammunition: Semis 20 rounds max. Bolts Actions 10 rounds max
Position: Prone
Exposure: 1x 20 seconds
Comments: Start standing back to targets, 2 yards away. Turn and engage target on signal
Start positions:
5.56 semis have magazine loaded but not inserted, bolt closed on empty chamber
7.62 (or similar calibre semis) have mags in, chamber loaded, safety on.
Bolt actions, magazine loaded and inserted, a round may be engaged by the extractor but bolt handle must be raised.

On signal engage target. Semis score will be halved.

Team match: Downfall Team shoot

(Optional, does not count for the Charles Upham)

Range: 75-175 yards

Target: Up to thirty steel plates

Ammunition: Unlimited

Position: One team member standing

One team member sitting, kneeling or squatting

One team member prone

Exposure: Two minutes

Possible score: 50 (team)

Comments: Slings optional. Timed scoring. On command, knock down plates in any sequence, 5 plates per bolt action, 10 per self-loading rifle. Fastest team wins. Any plates standing after two minutes will be scored as DNF.

Prize giving will be held at the end of Day two at the NZDA Kaitoke range

Entry Fee \$80.00, single day \$40.00

Entrants using as issued/general issue service rifles or civilian counterparts will compete in Service Class.

Rifles and Ammunition submitted for Service Class must conform to NZSRA SMC 4.0.

Service class rifles, magazines and slings must be presented at scrutineering and competitors must bring 5 extra rounds to supply for checking. These may be taken at random for checking at any time over the two days. Match Directors decision final.

Any target, hunting, tactical or similar rifle not fitting into service class may complete in Open Class. Open class also does not require service compliant ammunition.

There is also a team's match open to service rifle competitors.

Prizes include: NZ Cavalry Champion Belt, Gold, Silver and Copper cased NRA medals, L1A1 trophy, Galatas and Malame trophies.

Target Service Pistol
Position 5 shot standing, 5 shot sitting/kneeling, 5 shots prone
Time 60 secs total
Comment Re-load per position change

Match 2

Action M
Distance 20 Metres
Target Service Pistol
Position 2 shots prone, 2 standing, 2 kneeling, 2 standing, 2 prone
Time 60 seconds
Comment Start with 5 rds loaded in the 45 position

Match 3

El Presidentie
Distance 7 yards
Target 3 x IPSC Targets
Comment Start from the 45 position, gun loaded. Engage target one with 1

shot, target two with 2, and target three with 3, reload then engage target three with 1 shot, target two with 2, and target one with 3 shots. Fastest time/score wins. Spare ammo and mags must be carried in Military type pouches. No ipsc rigs allowed.

Match 4

Snap
Distance 7 yards
Target 3 x IPSC Targets

Comment Start from the 45 position, gun loaded. Engage targets with two shots each. From standing, drop to kneeling/sitting, reload and repeat. Fastest time/score wins. Spare ammo and mags must be carried in Military type pouches. No ipsc rigs allowed.

Match 1

Solids - Application

Distance 50 Metres
Target Service Pistol
Ammunition 7 rounds (includes 2 sighters)
Position Optional
Time 2 minutes

Match 2

Static Clays x10

Distance 8 to 10 Metres
Target 10 x 4 inch square light steel plates
Ammunition 12 Bird shot max
Position Standing
Comment Plates on poles at various heights and distances.

Match starts with shotgun horizontal, arms held straight down, 5 rounds in magazine, 1 round in Chamber. On command engage plates in any Sequence. Re-load any time after the first shot, five Second penalty for each plate left standing.

Match 3

Static Clays x5

Distance 8 to 10 Metres
Target 5 x 4 inch square light steel plates
Ammunition 6 Bird shot max
Position Standing
Comment Similar to above but only 5 plates, start the same.6 rounds in gun

Match 4

Solids - Action M

Distance 50 Metres
Target Service Pistol
Ammunition 5 rounds
Position 1 prone, 1 standing, 1sitting/kneeling, 1 standing, 1 prone
Time 60 seconds

Note: These results will be added to those of the CU rifle champs to gain an overall Service Challenge 2012 winner. Medals will be given for 1st 2nd and 3rd in all matches for Service Class and 1st, 2nd, 3rd overall in Open class.
